DECISION

This is an application by **Empire Hotel Featherston Limited** for a renewal on-licence in respect of premises situated **37 Johnston Street, Featherston** known as **Empire Hotel**

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **tavern and restaurant**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the applicant a renewal on-licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

REASON FOR DECISION

Having regard for the information supplied by the Licensing Inspector and Reporting Agencies supporting the Application the District Licensing Chair acting pursuant to s.131 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants the renewal On Licence in respect of the premises at 37 Johnston Street, Featherston known as the Empire Hotel, subject to the following conditions (a) to (l).

CONDITIONS

The licence may issue with the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises for the purpose of dining
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday between 9:00 am to 1:00am the following day
- (c) The licensee must ensure at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed inside the premises, so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- (d) The Main Bar, garden bar and North East Lounge and bar as shown on the site plan provided with the application are designated as "**Supervised**".
- (e) The Class 4 Gambling area as shown on the site plan provided with the application is designated as "**Restricted**" as defined by the Gambling Act 2004.

- (f) Drinking water must be freely available to customers at all times while the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (g) Food must be available for consumption at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
- (h) A reasonable range of non-alcohol and low alcohol beverages must be available for consumption at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (i) A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol and their name must be prominently displayed.
- (j) Information, advice and assistance about alternative transport options must be freely given to guests on the licensed premises.
- (k) The responsible consumption of alcohol is to be promoted at all times by instigating and maintaining the steps outlined in the application for the licence and displaying the host responsibility policy at all times.
- (l) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age
 - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol

ON-LICENCE
(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), **Empire Hotel Featherston Limited** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at **37 Johnston Street, Featherston** and known as "**Empire Hotel**", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a **tavern and restaurant**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises for the purpose of dining
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday between 9:00 am to 1:00am the following day
- (c) The licensee must ensure at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed inside the premises, so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- (d) The Main Bar, garden bar and North East Lounge and bar as shown on the site plan provided with the application are designated as "**Supervised**".
- (e) The Class 4 Gambling area as shown on the site plan provided with the application is designated as "**Restricted**" as defined by the Gambling Act 2004.
- (f) Drinking water must be freely available to customers at all times while the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (g) Food must be available for consumption at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol. The range must be in accordance with the menu submitted with this application or of a similar range and standard. Food must be actively promoted and available within a reasonable time of ordering.
- (h) A reasonable range of non-alcohol and low alcohol beverages must be available for consumption at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (i) A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol and their name must be prominently displayed.
- (j) Information, advice and assistance about alternative transport options must be freely given to guests on the licensed premises.
- (k) The responsible consumption of alcohol is to be promoted at all times by instigating and maintaining the steps outlined in the application for the licence and displaying the host responsibility policy at all times.
- (l) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age
 - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at **37 Johnston Street, Featherston**, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on **11th September 2018**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S


A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **37 Johnston Street, Featherston** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) Either –
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
