ON-LICENCE

(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act), Rabbit 22 Ltd is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at 107 Dry River Road Martinborough and known as "3 Little Words", to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is a winery cellar door

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act

CONDITIONS

No alcohol is to be sold, supplied or consumed on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1:00 pm on Anzac Day to any (a) person unless:

they are people who are present on the premises to dine

Alcohol may only be available for sale, supply or consumption on the following days and during the following hours: (b)

Monday to Wednesday 11:00am to 10:00pm Thursday to Sunday 10:00am to 12:00am midnight

Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises at all times that alcohol (c) is available for sale, supply and consumption.

Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of (d) alcohol, in accordance with the menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.

The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol: (e)

Implement and maintain the Host Responsibility Policy submitted with the application for the licence.

At all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply or consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol options are available.

The Licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing the availability of assistance and information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.

- The licensee must implement and maintain steps proposed in the application for the license aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are (f) observed:

A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.

Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

The premises is to be: Supervised

- The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed at the principal entrance so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- The holder of a manager's certificate or a properly notified manager shall be on duty and on the premises at all times alcohol is (i) available for sale, supply and consumption.
- A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport & staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for (j) alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at 107 Dry River Road Martinborough, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on 15th November 2022.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from 107 Dry River Road Martinborough is designated as the principal entrance.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provision of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

(a)Either -

Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or

If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but ii. RAPA DISTRICT

(b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either -

Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or

If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

DECISION

This is an application by **Rabbit 22 Ltd** for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 107 Dry River Road Martinborough, known as "**3 Little Words**". The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **Winery Cellar Door**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

REASON FOR DECISION:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Alcohol Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the issue of the licence. In addition, the District Licensing Committee has received no objections from the community.

I, as the District Licensing Committee Chair:

- a. Am satisfied as to the matters to which the Committee must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act; and
- b. Acting pursuant to s127 of the Act, grant Rabbit 22 Ltd known as 3 Little Words an onlicence pursuant to section 14 of the Act, authorising the sale and supply of liquor for consumption on the premises, subject to the conditions of licence 1 to 10.

CONDITIONS:

1. Alcohol may only be available for sale, supply or consumption on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Wednesday 11:00am to 10:00pm.

Thursday to Sunday 10:00am to 12:00am midnight.

- No alcohol is to be sold, supplied or consumed on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas
 Day or before 1:00 pm on Anzac Day to any person unless: they are people who are
 present on the premises to dine.
- The premises is designated: supervised.
- 4. The holder of a manager's certificate or a properly notified manager shall be on duty and on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale, supply and consumption.
- Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises at all times that alcohol is available for sale, supply and consumption.
- 6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the menu supplied with

the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.

- The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
 - Implement and maintain the Host Responsibility Policy submitted with the application for the licence.
 - b. At all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply or consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol options are available.
 - c. The Licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing the availability of assistance and information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
 - d. The licensee must implement and maintain steps proposed in the application for the license aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- 8. The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - a. A restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.
 - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- 9. The licensee must ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed at the principal entrance so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport & staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.56, 57 and 214 (3) of the Act obliging the holder of an onlicence to display:

- a. At each principal entrance to the premises a sign attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; <u>AND</u>
- A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; <u>AND</u>
- A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
