

Update of road closures for the unveiling of the Featherston Memorial Sculpture and Memorial Service for Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 November 2018.

Road closures will take place on State Highway 2 and its intersections with local roads from Daniell Street to Camp Road. SWDC has approved the TMP (Traffic Management Plan) for the closure of the local roads. Capital Journeys (NZTA) has approved the TMP for the closure of State Highway 2.

Initially road closures advertised in the Midweek newspaper were from 7:00am to 7:00pm as proposed by the Traffic Management provider, thus enabling correct signage and delineations (cones) to be set up.

However, following a review, the revised road closure times have been amended to:

Saturday 10 November:

- State Highway 2 will be closed from Daniell Street to Camp Road from 2:30pm to 5:30 pm
- The intersections of local roads* to SH2 will begin closing from 12:00 noon and will be open again by 7:00pm.

Sunday 11 November

- State Highway 2 will be closed from Daniell Street to Camp Road from 11.00 am to 12.00 noon
- The intersections of local roads* to SH2 will begin closing from 8:00am and open again by 2:00pm

*The following roads with intersections to State Highway 2 will be affected: Birdwood Street, Lyon Street, Fox Street, Waite Street, Hickson Street, Donald Street, Wallace Street and Boundary Road.

There will be a detour for vehicles travelling between Featherston and Greytown:

- Featherston to Greytown – Fitzherbert Street (SH2) closed at Daniell Street:
 - turn right onto Daniell Street, turn left onto Revans Street (SH53), turn left onto Camp Road, turn right onto SH2
- Greytown to Featherston – SH 2 closed at Camp Road:
 - turn left onto Camp Road, turn right onto SH53
