**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for the **Wairarapa Racing Club Inc Melbourne Cup Cocktail Function** to be held at **62 Bell Street, Featherston** and known as **Anzac Hall, Featherston**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

**Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

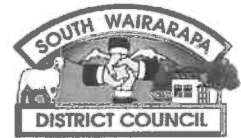
1. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of liquor to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied liquor.
  - (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
2. Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours.  
26th July 2014: 6 pm - 9.00pm.
3. Food as described in the menu must be available at all times that alcohol is being sold or supplied.
4. Low alcohol beverages and non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises. Non-alcoholic and low alcohol drinks availability must be promoted.
5. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the licensed premises: Display contact details of the local taxi company and other public transport details at the bar
6. The kinds of alcohol that may be sold or delivered from the premises are beer and wine.
7. Free water stations are to be located at the bar..

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **WAIRARAPA RACING CLUB INC** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **62 Bell Street, Featherston** and known as **Anzac Hall, Featherston** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Melbourne Cup Cocktail Function**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of liquor to prohibited persons are observed:
