DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for a *Fundraising Event – 'Inspiring Women' for St Teresa's School* to be held at **38 Donald Street, Featherston 5710** and known as *Tarureka Estate, Featherston*, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.


Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

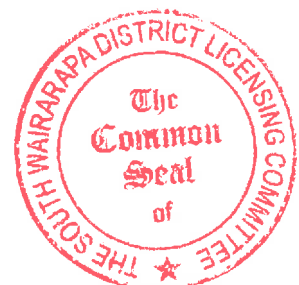
LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
30th July 2015 6.15pm to 10.00pm
2. Alcohol may be sold or supplied to the following types of people: members of the general public who hold a ticket to the event
3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcoholic refreshments
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied
5. Drinking water is to be freely available
6. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed: One certified manager will be on duty at all times
7. A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises
8. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - I. intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - II. if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
 - III. display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

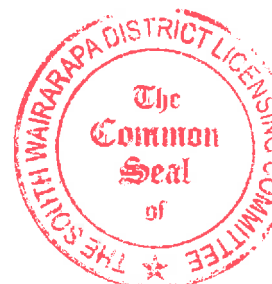
