Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **PEAK BREWERY LTD** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **89 Martins Rd, Martinborough**, and known as **Te Kairanga Vineyard**, to any person attending the following occasion or event:

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

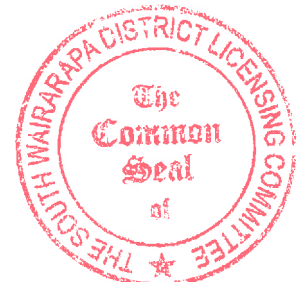
1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
1 November 2015, 6 December 2015, 3 January 2016, 7 February 2016, 6 March 2016 3 April 2016
10.00am to 2.00pm
2. Alcohol may be sold or supplied to the following types of people: public attending the farmers market
3. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: **display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons**
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed: **One certified manager will be on duty at all times**
5. Drinking water must be freely available at all times while the premises are open for business: **Potable water is to be available at the bar**
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows: A range of food stalls must be selling and supplying food during the event
7. low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows: Peak Brewery Titter Down Lightly 2.5% beer or other less than 2.5% alcohol beverage
8. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
9. Alcohol may be sold in the following types of container only: **Bottles and plastic beakers.**
10. A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for ***Te Kairanga Farmers Market*** to be held at ***89 Martins Rd, Martinborough***, and known as ***Te Kairanga Vineyard***, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified. Accordingly I deal with the matters on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142. of the Act. I grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, I set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

LICENCE CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours: 1 November 2015, 6 December 2015, 3 January 2016, 7 February 2016, 6 March 2016 3 April 2016
10.00am to 2.00pm
- Alcohol may be sold or supplied to the following types of people: public attending the farmers market
- The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: **display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons**
- The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed: **One certified manager will be on duty at all times**
- Drinking water must be freely available at all times while the premises are open for business: **Potable water is to be available at the bar**
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows: A range of food stalls must be selling and supplying food during the event

- low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows: Peak Brewery Titter Down Lightly 2.5% beer or other less than 2.5% alcohol beverage
- Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- Alcohol may be sold in the following types of container only: **Bottles and plastic beakers.**
- A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises.
