### Special Licence

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **LICENCE CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Saturday 2 April 2016 and Sunday 3 April 2016 - 10:00am to 4:00pm**
2. Drinking water is to be freely available at the stall site.
3. A copy of this licence must be displayed at each point of sale so as to be easily read by persons present on the premises
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure the provisions of this Act relating to the management of the premises are observed: A certificated manager must be on duty.
5. The following steps must be taken by the licensee to ensure that the following provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) if a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
  - (iii) display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **French Country Fair** to be held at **1498 State Highway 2 Featherston 5771** and known as **Tauherenikau Racecourse**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. I grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, I set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:
