DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for to be held at **Various**, and known as various, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

The DLC has considered the Inspector's Report and noted there is no objection from the Reporting Agencies. However it is noted that there should be a Certified Manager on duty for the Awards Ceremony and that management consider undertaking the free training available for key staff members, and that the provision of transport providers be made available so they are able to fully comply with the Sale & Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The Licence is therefore accordingly granted to the South Wairarapa District Council pursuant to s22 of the Sale & Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
 - 4 Citizenship ceremonies
 - 1 award ceremony
 - February – December 2019
2. The licensee must notify the DLC Chairperson of the date of each event prior to the event occurring.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times during the awards ceremony when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. An executive manager is required to be on duty for the citizenship ceremonies and is responsible for ensuring the licensee is compliant with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.

7. At the awards ceremony the licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
8. At the citizenship ceremonies the licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
9. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
10. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests.
11. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **SOUTH WAIRARAPA DISTRICT COUNCIL** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **Various**, and known as **Various** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Citizenship and Awards ceremony**


The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
4 Citizenship ceremonies, 1 award ceremony
February – December 2019
2. The licensee must notify the DLC Chairperson of the date of each event prior to the event occurring.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times during the awards ceremony when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. An executive manager is required to be on duty for the citizenship ceremonies and is responsible for ensuring the licensee is compliant with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
7. At the awards ceremony the licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
8. At the citizenship ceremonies the licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
9. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
10. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests.
11. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
