

**IN THE MATTER** of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**IN THE MATTER** of an application by **Functionmaster Hotels Limited** for a Special Licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act in respect of premises situated at **133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough** and known as **Luna Estate**

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for to be held at **133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough** and known as **Luna Estate**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

**Reason for decision:**

The DLC has read the Inspector's Report and noted that the Reporting Agencies have raised no objections. Having regard to the information supporting the Application and the Applicant meeting relevant statutory criteria under section 22 of the Sale & Supply of Alcohol Act the licence is therefore granted accordingly.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

**Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2019, 4.00 pm to 9.30 pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certified manager is to be present at each bar where alcohol is being sold or supplied.
4. A minimum of 6 certified managers are to be on duty.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and

- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
10. A maximum of four alcoholic beverages can be supplied per person per transaction. The beverages include a 375 mL serve for beer, cider and RTDs, a 150 mL serve for wine.
11. A person is only able to purchase one 750 mL bottle of wine.
12. Alcohol is to be sold in plastic cups, PET bottles with caps removed, cans fully opened or glass bottles up to 750 mL with cap/cork removed and a \$5 return surcharge.
13. The sale of 750 mL bottles of wine are to cease at 8.00 pm.
14. No alcohol is to be removed from the premises and includes empty containers.

## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **FUNCTIONMASTER HOTELS LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **133 Puruatanga Road, Martinborough** and known as **Luna Estate** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Marlon Williams Concert**


The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 9.00 am to 12 noon
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a range of non-alcoholic beverages such as those stipulated in the application.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
