DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Day trip to Wairarapa** to be held at **various via conveyance**, and known as **Charter Bus**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

I have considered this Application on the basis of the report and recommendations received from the Licensing Inspector who do not oppose the issue of the Special Licence for the Charter Bus fundraising tour. The District Licensing Chair acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act therefore accordingly grants the Licence subject to the following conditions 1-10ii.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the New Zealand Coach Service chartered bus for the Keelan Whanau Ireland Fundraiser, Wairarapa Day Trip only on the following days and hours:
Saturday 6th April 2019, 1:00 pm to 6:00pm
2. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the conveyance is open for business: at the front of the bus.
3. The person nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times the conveyance is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the conveyance at all times for the supply and consumption of alcohol is available on the bus, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.

5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when on the conveyance for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a range of non-alcohol and low alcohol options such as those stipulated in the application.
6. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the bus so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
7. Members of the public must be excluded from the conveyance.
8. Alcohol may be sold and supplied only to the following types of people: valid ticket holders
9. Alcohol can only be supplied in the following types of containers only: Paper/plastic cups and cans
10. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be sold or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **MAUMAHARA AMIRIA KEELAN** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **various via conveyance**, and known as **Charter Bus** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Day trip to Wairarapa**

The District Licensing Committee has granted an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act for the requirement to have a certificate holding manager.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the New Zealand Coach Service chartered bus for the Keelan Whanau Ireland Fundraiser, Wairarapa Day Trip only on the following days and hours:

2. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the conveyance is open for business: at the front of the bus.
