**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **62 Bell Street, Featherston** to be held at **62 Bell Street, Featherston** and known as **Anzac Hall**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

**Reason for decision:**

Having regard for the Licensing Inspector's report and recommendations supporting the Application the District Licensing Chair therefore accordingly grants the Special Licence to Janet Anne Velvin for the Fulton family reunion, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

**Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2019, 7.00 pm to 11:30pm**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a range of non-alcoholic beverages such as those stipulated in the application.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and

- b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: Invited guests only
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
- (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

### Special Licence

#### **Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012**

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **JANET ANNE VELVIN** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **62 Bell Street, Featherston** and known as **Anzac Hall** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):  
Family reunion

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2019, 7.00 pm to 11:30pm**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
