**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Staff Social events and Christmas Function** to be held at **6 Wakelin Street, Greytown** and known as **Kuranui College Staff Room and Courtyard**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

**Reason for decision:**

On reading the Licensing Inspector's report and supporting information the District Licensing Chair acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act therefore accordingly grants the Special Licence to the Kuranui College Board of Trustees, subject to the following conditions.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019, 3:30pm to 5:30pm**  
**Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019, 3:30pm to 5:30pm**  
**Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2019, 11:00am to 4:00pm**
2. The staffroom and courtyard area is designated 'supervised'.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. The person nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times the conveyance is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu

supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.

6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
  - d. Signage relating to minimising alcohol related harm to be provided by the reporting agencies.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: invited guests
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

### Special Licence

#### **Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012**

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **KURANUI COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **6 Wakelin Street, Greytown** and known as **Kuranui College Staff Room and Courtyard** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): Staff Social events and Christmas Function

#### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019, 3:30pm to 5:30pm**  
**Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019, 3:30pm to 5:30pm**  
**Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2019, 11:00am to 4:00pm**
2. The staffroom and courtyard area is designated 'supervised'.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. The person nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol must be on duty at all times the conveyance is open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
