

## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **NGAWI SPORTS FISHING CLUB INC** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **3111 Cape Palliser Road, RD 2 Featherston** and known as **Ngawi Community Hall** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Ngawi Sports Fishing Club Big 3 2021

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.


#### Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
Thursday 18 February 2021 – 3:00pm to 10:00pm  
Friday 19 February 2021 – 1:00pm to 12:00am midnight  
Saturday 20 February 2021 – 1:00pm to 2:00am the following day  
Sunday 21 February 2020 – 10:00am to 10:00pm
2. The licensed area is undesignated until 9:00pm. From 9:00pm the licensed area is designated “supervised”
3. A certified duty manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: competition entrants, guests of entrants, and club members
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

**Duration This licence is in force on 18 February 2021 from 3:00pm to 10:00pm, 19 February 2021 from 1:00pm to 12:00am, 20 February 2021 from 1:00pm to 2:00am, 21 February 2021**

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Big 3 2021** to be held at **3111 Cape Palliser Road, RD 2 Featherston** and known as **Ngawi Community hall**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

**Reason for decision:**

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector, the Police, and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the application. The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s. 22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants this Special License subject to the following conditions 1 to 9.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

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2. The licensed area is undesignated until 9:00pm. From 9:00pm the licensed area is designated "**supervised**"
3. A certified duty manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
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  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: competition entrants, guests of entrants, and club members.
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol.
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
