 - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 5. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for Escarpment Winery Limited, known as Escarpment, for alcohol to be tasted during Tasting Weekends and sold for consumption offsite from the premises at 275 Te Muna Road, Martinborough.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police, who do not oppose the application. The Medical Officer of Health chose not to report on this application. The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants this Special Licence subject to the following conditions of the licence, set under s147.

Conditions

1. Alcohol may be tasted, sold or supplied for consumption off the premises only on the following days and hours:

Friday 20 May 2022 - 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Saturday 21 May 2022 - 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Friday 27 May 2022 - 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Saturday 28 May 2022 - 8:00am to 6:00pm.

2. The licensed premises are designated: supervised.
