Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **FEATHERSTON BOOKTOWN TRUST** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **60 Johnston Street Featherston** and known as **Featherston Sports Hub** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Hear Me Roar, 50 Years of Read NZ, Late Nite Lit, and Mrs Blackwell's High Tea

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Saturday 11 June 2022 – 6:00pm – 11:00pm
Sunday 12 June 2022 – 2:30pm to 5:00pm
2. The licensed area is **undesignated**
3. A certified duty manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: **ticket holding guests**
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Duration This licence is in force on **11 June 2022 from 6:00pm to 11:00pm and 12 June 2022 from 2:30pm to 4:00pm**

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Hear Me Roar, 50 years of Read NZ, Late Nite Lit, and Mrs Blackwell's High Tea** to be held at **60 Johnston Street Featherston** (known as **Featherston Sports Hub**) where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s.141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.3, s.4, s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Reason for decision:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police, who do not oppose the application. The Medical Officer of Health chose not to report on this application. The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants this Special Licence subject to the following conditions of the licence, set under s147.
