Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **MRS BLACKWELL LTD** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **102 Main Street, Greytown** and known as **Truckstop Greytown** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Greytown Festival of Christmas

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

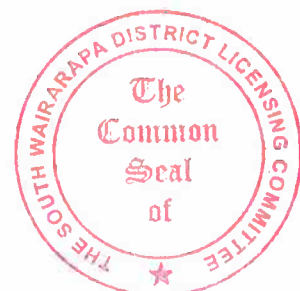
This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed on the premises only on the following day and hours:
 - Friday 1 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Saturday 2 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Friday 8 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Saturday 9 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Friday 15 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Saturday 16 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Friday 22 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Saturday 23 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Friday 29 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Saturday 30 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certified manager must be on duty at all times, at each bar, when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (a) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (b) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
8. The licensed area is defined as per the site plan presented in the application documentation.

Duration This licence is in force on **1 and 2 July 2022 from 4pm to 8pm, 8 and 9 July 2022 from 4pm to 8pm, 15 and 16 July 2022 from 4pm to 8pm, 22 and 23 July 2022 from 4pm to 8pm and 29 and 30 July 22 from 4pm to 8pm**

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is by **Mrs Blackwell Ltd** for **Truckstop Greytown** during the **Greytown Mid-Winter Festival** to be held at **102 Main Street, Greytown**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publically notified.

Reason for decision:

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector, the Police, and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4, s.142 and s.143 of the Act.

The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants this Special Licence subject to the following conditions of the licence, set under s147.

Conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed on the premises only on the following day and hours:
 - **Friday 1 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Saturday 2 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Friday 8 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Saturday 9 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Friday 15 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Saturday 16 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**

- **Friday 22 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Saturday 23 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Friday 29 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
 - **Saturday 30 July 2022 – 4:00pm to 8:00pm.**
2. A certified manager must be on duty at all times, at each bar, when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
 3. The licensed area of the premises for the duration of the events are **undesignated**.
 4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
 6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
 7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
 8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
