

## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **SOUTH WAIRARAPA BRIDGE CLUB INC** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **89 Main Street Greytown** and known as **Greytown Town Centre** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

#### **South Wairarapa Bridge Club Christmas Party**

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Monday 5 December 2022 – 6:00pm to 10:00pm**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. The licensed area of the premises is to be **undesigned**
4. The requirement for a certified duty manager is exempted and replaced by the requirement for a nominated person to be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

**Duration** This licence is in force on **5 December 2022 from 6pm to 10pm**

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is from South Wairarapa Bridge Club for a **Christmas Function** to be held at **89 Main Street Greytown**, and known as **Greytown Town Centre**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s.141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

**Reason for decision:**

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police, who do not oppose the application. The Medical Officer of Health chose not to report on this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4, s.142 and s.143 of the Act.

The South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s.22 of the Act, therefore accordingly grants this Special Licence subject to the following conditions of the licence, set under s147.

**Conditions**

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Monday 5 December 2022 – 6:00pm to 10:00pm.**
2. The licensed area of the premises is to be **undesignated.**
3. The requirement for a certified duty manager is exempted and replaced by the requirement for a nominated person to be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.

5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale, detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
  - a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol.
  - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
