## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **MARTINBOROUGH SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **Martinborough Village and Memorial Square Martinborough**, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

#### Round the Vines

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Saturday 4 November 2023 9:00am to 2:30pm**
2. No alcohol sold or supplied at the main bar on Memorial Square is permitted to leave the cordoned area identified on the map supplied with the application.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at each drink station and the main bar.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.
6. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times at the drink stations and bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
7. The licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. The bar located in Memorial Square is to be designated: **supervised**. All other areas of the fun run course are to be **undesignated**.
9. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: valid ticket holders and/or event attendees.
10. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
11. Each alcohol tasting is to be no more than 30mL of product per serve.

The above conditions are consistent with those associated with an off-site special licence.

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Round the Vines** to be held at **Martinborough Village and Memorial Square Martinborough**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we 1-11 must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-11.

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

**Saturday 4 November 2023 9:00am to 2:30pm**


2. No alcohol sold or supplied at the main bar on Memorial Square is permitted to leave the cordoned area identified on the map supplied with the application.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at each drink station and the main bar.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable

range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.

6. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times at the drink stations and bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
