

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **TOAST MARTINBOROUGH LTD** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **89 Martins Road, Martinborough** and known as **The Runholder** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Toast Martinborough

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed on the premises only on the following day and hours:
Sunday 19 November 2023 - 10:00am to 6:00pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certified manager must be on duty at all times, at each bar, when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages such as those stipulated in the application.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders presenting an official Toast Martinborough wristband and festival glass.
8. Wine must be supplied only in an official "Toast" festival wine glass.
9. Festival beer must be supplied in either a plastic beer cup that takes 330ml or an approved supplier beer can.
10. A maximum of four (4) alcoholic beverages can be served per person for each sale.
11. Pour volumes are not to exceed:
 - (a) 75 ml for a "taste";
 - (b) 150 ml for a "full glass" of wine;
 - (c) 330ml for beer.
12. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (a) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (b) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
12. The licensed area is defined as per the site plan presented in the application documentation.
13. The Licensee must comply with the Alcohol Management Plan (AMP) that was presented in the application documentation.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Toast Martinborough** to be held at **89 Martins Road, Martinborough** and known as **The Runholder**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-14.

1. Alcohol may be sold, supplied and consumed on the premises only on the following day and hours:


Sunday 19 November 2023 - 10:00am to 6:00pm

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certified manager must be on duty at all times, at each bar, when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.

12. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol.
 - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
13. The licensed area is defined as per the site plan presented in the application documentation.

14. The Licensee must comply with the Alcohol Management Plan (AMP) that was presented in the application documentation.
