- 4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.
- 5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times at the drink stations and bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The whole of the licensed area is to be designated as: supervised
- 8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: event attendees.
- The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (iii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for Glass on the Green to be held at 50 Kitchener Street Martinborough, and known as Grava, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s3, s4 and s142 and s143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s22 subject to the restrictions imposed by \$147 with the following conditions 1-9.

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on and off the premises only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 18 November 2023 11:00am to 4:00pm

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.
- 5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times at the drink stations and bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The whole of the licensed area is to be designated as: **supervised.**
- 8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to event attendees.
- 9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol, and
 - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
