Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, WESTERN LAKE GUN CLUB is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 2812 Western Lake Road Featherston, and known as Western Lake Gun Club to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Clay Target Shooting Season

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Sunday 21st January 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 2nd March 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 7th April 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 2nd June 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 4th August 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 6th October 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 2nd November 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 7th December 2024 – 10:00am to 10:00pm

2. Alcohol is not to be sold and supplied to or consumed by any person who will possibly be handling a firearm that day (e.g. shoot, pack up and store firearms, then socialise with a drink).
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. The designation of the premises is outlined as follows: **supervised**
5. The requirement for a certified duty manager is exempted and replaced by the requirement for a nominated person to be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol.
7. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
8. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
9. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Duration This licence is in force on 21 January 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 2 March 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 7 April 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 2 June 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 4 August 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 6 October 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm, 2 November 2024 from 10:00am to 6:00pm and 7 December 2024 from 10:00am to 10:00pm

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Clay Target Shooting Season** to be held at 2812 **Western Lake Road Featherston**, and known as **Western Lake Gun Club** where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-9.

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Sunday 21st January 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 2nd March 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 7th April 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 2nd June 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 4th August 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Sunday 6th October 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 2nd November 2024 – 10:00am to 6:00pm
Saturday 7th December 2024 – 10:00am to 10:00pm
