

### Special Licence

#### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **CARTER CONSULTANTS** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **58 Moroa Road Tauwherenikau**, and known as to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

#### **Gintastic Wairarapa**

*(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act)* The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Friday 8 March 2024 – 5:30pm to 8:00pm**  
**Saturday 9 March 2024 – 12:00pm to 6:00pm**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.
5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The whole of the licensed area is to be designated as: **Restricted**
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders only.
9. A maximum of 2 alcoholic beverages are to be sold to any one person at a time, reducing to a maximum of 1 alcoholic beverage per person from 4:00pm onwards.
10. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

**Duration** This licence is in force on **8 March 2024 from 5:30pm to 8:00pm** and **9<sup>th</sup> March 2024 from 12:00pm to 6:00pm**

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Gintastic Wairarapa** to be held at **58 Moroa Road Tauherenikau**, and known as **Greytown Honey**

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-10.

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

**Friday 8 March 2024 – 5:30pm to 8:00pm**  
**Saturday 9 March 2024 – 12:00pm to 6:00pm**

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a reasonable range of food in accordance with the menus supplied with the application or a variation of a similar range and standard.

5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The whole of the licensed area is to be designated as: **Restricted**.
8. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: ticket holders only.
