Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, FEATHERSTON RUGBY CLUB INCORPORATED is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 60 Johnston Street, Featherston and known as Featherston Rugby Club to any person attending the following occasion or event (*or* series of occasions or events):

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

 Friday 14 June 2024 6:00pm to 10:00pm
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises at all times that alcohol is available for sale, supply and consumption.
- 3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a range of non-alcoholic beverages such as those stipulated in the application.
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. Alcohol may be supplied only to the following types of people: valid ticket holders.
- The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Duration This licence is in force on 14 June 2024 from 6:00pm to 10:00pm



DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for St Teresa's School Fundraising Bingo Night to be held at 60 Johnston Street, Featherston and known as Featherston Rugby Club, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-8.

1. Alcohol may be supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Friday 14 June 2024 - 6:00pm to 10:00pm

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises at all times that alcohol is available for sale, supply and consumption.
- 3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the supply and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises is open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol, a range of non-alcoholic beverages such as those stipulated in the application.
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:

- a. At every point of supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
- b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. Alcohol may be supplied only to valid ticket holders.
- 8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply to prohibited persons.
 - a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol, and
 - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
