

Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **TIRAU LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **108 Main Street Greytown**, and known as **The Laneway Market** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Greytown Midwinter Christmas Festival

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption off the premises only on the following days and hours:
Saturday 29 June 2024 – 2:30pm to 8:30pm
Saturday 05 July 2024 – 2:30pm to 8:30pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. Alcohol tasting sizes are limited to 12mL.
4. All alcohol products for consumption off the premises must be sold in a sealed container.
5. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

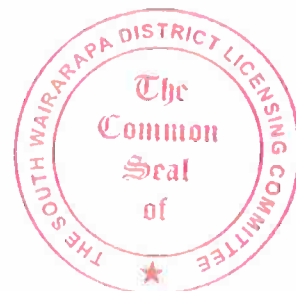
The above conditions are consistent with those associated with an off-site special licence.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Greytown Midwinter Christmas Festival** to be held at **108 Main Street Greytown**, and known as **The Laneways Market**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-7.


1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption off the premises only on the following days and hours:

**Saturday 29 June 2024 – 2:30pm to 8:30pm, and
Saturday 05 July 2024 – 2:30pm to 8:30pm**

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. Alcohol tasting sizes are limited to 12mL
4. All alcohol products for consumption off the premises must be sold in a sealed container.
5. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:

- a. At every point of sale/supply a sign detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
- a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol, and
 - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
