

## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **MARTINBOROUGH SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **192 Regent Street, Martinborough**, and known as **Dry River Wines** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

#### **Round the Vines - fun run/walk**

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Saturday 1 November 2025 – 9:00am to 1:00pm**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the drink station.
3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times at the bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
5. The drink stations are to be designated: **undesignated**.
6. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: valid ticket holders and/or event attendees.
7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Round the Vines - fun run/walk** to be held at **192 Regent Street, Martinborough**, and known as **Dry River Wines**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-7.


1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

**Saturday 1 November 2025 – 9:00am to 1:00pm**

2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the drink station.
3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times at the bar when they are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
4. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and

- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 5. The drink stations are to be designated: **undesigned**.
- 6. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to valid ticket holders and/or event attendees.
- 7. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
  - a. Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol, and
  - b. If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.
