

## Special Licence

### Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **NGAWI SPORTS FISHING CLUB INCORPORATED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **3111 Cape Palliser Road, Ngawi**, and known as **Ngawi Sports Fishing Club Incorporated** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

#### **Ngawi Big 3 – Annual Fishing Competition 2026**

*(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act)* The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises to event participants only on the following days and hours:

**Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 3:00pm to 10:00pm**  
**Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 1:00pm to 12:00am midnight**  
**Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2026 – 1:00pm to 1:00am the following day**  
**Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 – 12:00pm to 9:00pm**

2. The event is to be designated as follows:

**Undesignated – between 10:00am to 9:00pm**  
**Supervised – between 9:00pm to 1:00am the following day**

3. A certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
- At every point of sale/supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
  - A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
  - A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
- Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
  - If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

**Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 1:00pm to 12:00am midnight**

**Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 – 12:00pm to 9:00pm**



**DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **Ngawi Big 3 – Annual Fishing Competition 2026** to be held at **3111 Cape Palliser Road, Ngawi**, and known as **Ngawi Sports Fishing Club Incorporated**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147 with the following conditions 1-8.

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises to event participants only on the following days and hours:

**Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 3:00pm to 10:00pm**  
**Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 1:00pm to 12:00am midnight**  
**Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2026 – 1:00pm to 1:00am the following day**  
**Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 – 12:00pm to 9:00pm**

2. The event is to be designated as follows:

**Undesignated – between 10:00am to 9:00pm**  
**Supervised – between 9:00pm to 1:00am the following day**

3. A certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
