



Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **GREYTOWN CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **Soldiers Memorial Park, 11-55 Kuratawai St Greytown** and known as **Soldiers Memorial Park** to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

Cricket and Cocktails

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

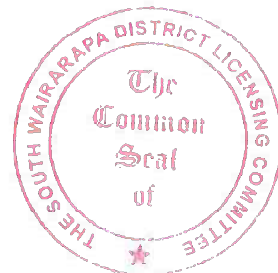
Conditions

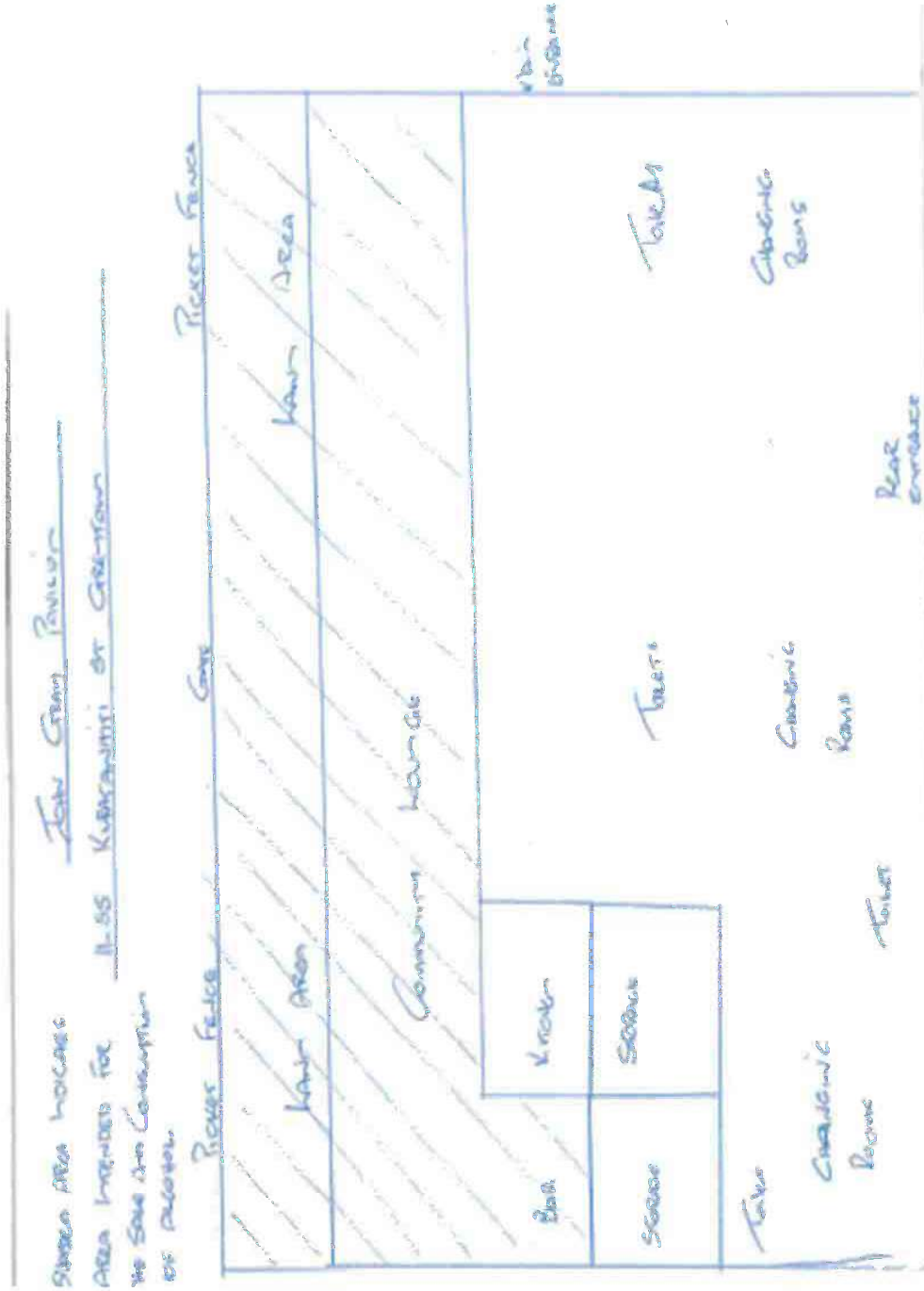
1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Saturday 28 March 2026 – 1:00pm to 9:00pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: event participants and their guests.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

IN THE MATTER of an application by **Greytown Cricket Club Incorporated** for a Special Licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act in respect of premises situated at **Soldiers Memorial Park, 11-55 Kuratawaiti St Greytown** and known as "**Soldiers Memorial Park**"

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for Cricket and Cocktails to be held at **Soldiers Memorial Park, 11-55 Kuratawaiti St Greytown** and known as **Soldiers Memorial Park**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 28 March 2026 – 1:00pm to 9:00pm
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificate holding manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:

- a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
7. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to the following types of people: event participants and their guests.
 8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale to prohibited persons.
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested
