Special Licence

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, GREYTOWN RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB INCORPORATED is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 123 East Street, Greytown and known as Greytown Rugby Football Club to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events):

150th Jubilee Celebration

(Except where the District Licensing Committee grants an exemption under section 213(2) of the Act) The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises to event participants only on the following days and hours:
Mix and Mingle Night - Friday 29 May 2026 – 5:30pm to 11:00pm
Senior A & B Matches (Game Day) - Saturday 30 May 2026 – 12:00pm to 5:00pm
Celebrity Match (Anniversary Memorial) – 31 May 2026 – 12:00pm to 11:00pm
2. Alcohol may only be sold and supplied only to the following types of people: event attendees.
3. The sponsor's tent is to be designated as: "supervised".
4. The clubrooms and adjacent outdoor area is to be "undesignated".
5. The Licensee must adhere to the Anniversary event plan submitted by them to the Inspector and the Police, and ensure the consumption of alcohol does not take place outside the designated "drinking zones" outlined in their plan. This includes the consumption of BYO alcohol.
6. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, at each drink station, when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
7. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
8. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
9. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
10. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale/supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
11. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for **150th Jubilee Celebration** to be held at **123 East Street, Greytown** and known as **Greytown Rugby Football Club**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

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2. Alcohol may only be sold and supplied only to the following types of people: event attendees.
3. The sponsor's tent is to be designated as: **"supervised"**.
4. The clubrooms and adjacent outdoor area is to be **"undesigned"**.
5. The Licensee must adhere to the Anniversary event plan submitted by them to the Inspector and the Police, and ensure the consumption of alcohol does not take place outside the designated "drinking zones" outlined in their plan. This includes the consumption of BYO alcohol.
