DECISION DETERMINED ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a Special Licence under section 22 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The application is for a series of **Educational Cooking Class Experiences** to be held at **9A Cologne Street, Martinborough**, and known as **The Prodigal Daughter Gourmet Lodge**, where alcohol will be consumed on the premises.

The application was sent to the Police, Inspector and Medical Officer of Health under s. 141 and no reports of opposition were received. The application was not required to be publicly notified.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 3, s. 4 and s.142 and s.143 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence in terms of s.22 subject to the restrictions imposed by s.147.

Accordingly, we set the following conditions under s147 on the licence:

Conditions

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises to event participants only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 01 August 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 08 August 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 15 August 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 22 August 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 29 August 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 10 October 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 31 October 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 14 November 2026 - 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 28 November 2026 – 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 05 December 2026 - 11:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday 19 December 2026 - 11:00am to 4:00pm
Sunday 31 January 2027 - 11:00am to 4:00pm

2. The event is to be designated as: **undesigned**
3. A certificate holding manager or the nominated person appointed in accordance with section 213 (2) of the Act must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.

6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages, at all times when the premises are open for the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol.
7. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale/supply detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; and
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
8. The licensee must ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act regarding sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons:
 - (i) Intoxicated persons and minors are not to be served or supplied alcohol
 - (ii) If a person's age is in doubt one of the approved forms of "evidence of age" documents must be requested.

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **THE PRODIGAL DAUGHTER LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **9A Cologne Street, Martinborough**, and known as **The Prodigal Daughter Gourmet Lodge** to any person attending the following series of occasions or events: **Educational Cooking Class Experiences**
