Highest or any tender not necessarily accepted.

Vehicle for sale by tender is on an "as is where is" basis.

Only successful tenders will be notified and no correspondence or discussion will be entered.

Only written tenders in a sealed envelope marked "Vehicle Tender" will be received and placed in the Council's tender box. Tenders must include a refundable deposit of \$100.00 (cash or cheque). The deposit will be refunded to unsuccessful bidders.

Successful tenders:

- Vehicles must be paid for by bank cheque or cash unless other arrangements have been made with South Wairarapa District Council.
- Vehicles must be removed from the premises by no later than 5 working days following tender closure.
- Evidence of the ownership transfer (NZTA receipt) from Council to the successful tenderer must be produced before the vehicle can be uplifted.

Suitable identification must be produced prior to uplifting vehicles:

- Driver's license
- Passport
- Birth Certificate
