- The connection to Council drainage network must be carried out by a certified drainlayer.
- Once your application is approved, you must arrange for the certified drainlayer to carry out the works.
- All work must comply with the Wellington Water Regional Standard for Water Services.
- The excavation must be large enough to allow the connection work to be done safely and must comply with the
 requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and all relevant regulations, including the Health and Safety in
 Employment Regulations 1995 and the Health and Safety at Work (General Risk and Workplace Management)
 Regulations 2016.
- You must provide Wellington Water at least 48 hours notice to test, inspect and approve the connection.
