Other feedback for the LTP

The suggestion that each town does not need its own transfer station for waste is MAD. I can think of no other word for it. Page 2 of the discussion document lists climate change as one of our five main challenges. It's not just one of them; it's the biggest. We need to stop emitting so much carbon by using our cars so much. Every time we drive our cars we are changing the climate. IT'S THAT SIMPLE! Therefore, it's ludicrous to suggest that Greytown people should transport their waste 13 kilometres to Featherston. How would they do it? With cars. If Cotter Street residents don't like the transfer station, that's their problem. It was there before any of them bought their properties. They can sell and move out. A functioning transfer station, with the facility to accept electronic as well as other kinds of waste, is an essential Council service. By all means shift it elsewhere in Greytown, but DO NOT CLOSE IT.

Page 4 discusses the transition to a low carbon economy. The four activities listed will achieve little in reducing our emissions. We need a serious effort in educating residents greatly to reduce their emissions. Encourage cycling and walking. Encourage people with small lawns to mow them with push mowers, getting a little exercise at the same time. The link www.swdc.govt.nz/climatechange does not work.

Decision #1: I'm happy with option 1, but it's vital that we add an independent water supply for Featherston. The Waiohine supply cannot serve both towns in dry summers.

Decision #2: I prefer road seal extensions to continue.

Decision #3: Before extending the footpath network, improve the existing footpaths—especially where they dip into gutters at road crossings. In Greytown many of these junctions are impossible to negotiate with a wheelchair.

Decision #6: I strongly oppose closing the Greytown recycling centre. Residents need this core council service. People who find the recycling centre 'inappropriate' should move elsewhere. Please extend the service at the recycling centre by accepting electronic waste. It is ludicrous to expect Greytown people to transport electronic waste to Martinborough.

Decision #7 (not included in the plan but vitally important): Build more social housing. Greytown has the land, at Westhaven in West Street (I don't know about Council land availability in our other two towns). Our district is rapidly becoming a ghetto for rich people living in mansions on life-style blocks with ride-on mowers, olive plantations and huge carbon footprints. Stop encouraging these types to move to South Wairarapa, and look after poor people instead.

3 Waters:

• The long term plan should address and encourage/require decentralised treatment solutions. Globally waste water treatment is becoming an issues specifically due to aging infrastructure and the cost to replace this.

• New developments should be required to include on site treatment with water reuse requirements. This will protect against climate change and also reduce the impact on potable water for irrigation purposes.

• Companies such as Fluence (https://www.fluencecorp.com/decentralized-wastewater-treatment/) are specialists in containerized solutions which treat waste water to class 1A water standards and this is increasingly important as globally over the next 20 years 3 waters infrastructure will be a larger problem

• Treating water to such a high standard easily with modular systems is the way of the future and will assist in resource consent conditions as discharge of water meets class 1A standards and therefore is not a hazard.

• Whilst infrastructure needs to be maintained for existing reticulations, centralised plants are both capex and opex inefficient. In addition the opportunity for water re-use is lost given this requires additional reticulation which is known to be costly.

 Given SWDC decentralized geography, new subdivisions should be required to manage and reticulate waste water treatment which will assist in the strategic goals of the proposed plan.
 Recycling:

• The justification for the removal of the recycling center is flawed. The majority of rural household rubbish is via gate collection through user pay bin collection.

Risks are also not articulated as it is highly likely that landfill refuse will increase as a direct impact of closure of the recycling center, not to mention the increased CO2 emissions as a direct result of those who still chose to recycle undertaking a significantly longer journey.

A recycling center must be provided in every town – otherwise this goes against the council's climate agenda.

• Removing accessibility to recycling facilities in the knowledge that landfill rates will increase will have a direct environmental impact that should not be ignored.

Spatial Plan Submission for the establishment of a refund mechanism for S127 RMA Variation to Consent fees

I take this opportunity to make application for the establishment of a refund mechanism relating to the SWDC application/processing fees for a S127 Variation of the Resource Management Act. It is additionally probable that other fees could suitably be included in this process.

#### Background

We recently had need to make application for a minor variation to a Subdivision Consent that had been granted. The current listed fees on the SWDC website 'Schedule of Fees & Charges 2020/21' as of 01/07/20 states an initial Subdivision Non-notified Consent ranges from \$1275 to \$1960, whilst a Consent Variation is charged at \$1755.

The associated wording on this same list states; All fees are a deposit only. Where the costs for processing an application exceed the fee deposit, the additional cost will be payable.

Is it not reasonable to assume that if any extra time is going to be calculated and additional fees demanded that the inverse should also apply? I had been led to understand that as our variation was minor we could expect a refund of a relevant portion of our \$1755 paid and it was specifically requested of council staff that a record of time spent on the matter be kept to determine this.

Following the granting of the variation it was requested as to whether a refund would be available and we were advised 'the \$1755 is a standard fee .. and is justified'. No refund.

#### Conclusion

I do not criticise the councils determination of applicable fees, and suspect the Variation fee is pitched at such a high level to discourage excessive use of it to seek amendments 'after the fact'.

However, I struggle to accept that the processing of a minor Variation to an already granted Consent would take a similar amount of work, and if it took more there is provision to charge additionally. Conversely if the processing time is justifiably less, the customer should be refunded accordingly. To not do so is unreasonable and simply unfair, not to mention a bad business practice, especially for a Local Authority.
