Feedback on wheels park - I fully support the proposal to have a wheels park at the Cotter Street/Perry Street intersection. With the Tararua Junction subdivision beginning this site is no longer on the edge of town, with ample activity occurring at the rail trail and the dog park to make this a hub of activity. I believe this will be a great asset to Greytown, ensuring we look after the well being of our young people - from toddler to teen and utilising an under utilised space.

If this was to go ahead, which I hope it will, I would like to see young people involved in the design of the park. Their input will encourage ownership and connection.

Thinking that this will be an attractant for undesirable behaviour is antiquated, wrong and doesn't align with reality. The benefits of a park outweigh the occasional 'bad egg' by a long shot. Wheels/skate parks are a place for young people to belong and be themselves while staying connected within a wider community, encourage physical activity and mental relief and give kids something to do (off a screen!)

My experience at wheels parks has been that older children look out for younger kids and new friendships are made.

One consideration is parking and road safety, but perhaps if the recycling centre was to move this would create an opportunity here. I'm sure the design process will address these concerns.

The preferred option to not continue with the sealing of Ruakokopatuna Road defies logic. It would leave us with three separate areas of gravel, interspersed with three sealed areas in the 5 kms to the Blue Rock Road intersection. Council will still have to use a grader for the gravel bits. As it is already, the immediate areas at either end of the newly sealed area are falling into potholes and potentially seriously eroding the ends of the seal. Do it once, do it right! In the twenty years since we moved here the original two areas of seal have not needed ANY maintenance. As it is, during the summer, we have an enormous dust nuisance, and in winter, mud up to our axles and many deep potholes, sometimes it is impossible to avoid them safely without being forced to drive erratically and on the wrong side of the road. This is a safety issue! And I hesitate to mention the wear and tear on our vehicles, needing wheel alignment, replacement sway bars and shock absorbers far in excess of normal.





As a local Living Streets Aotearoa member, we strongly agree with improving footpaths. Continued pressure on Waka Kotahi to create crossings south of the railway line and improve the junctions for people on foot or bikes is essential.

If berms are not to be mown by Council, consider encouraging residents to plant them rather than all mowing them. More native plants could be used for street trees and along streamsides to encourage the links between Tararua Ranges, Wairarapa Moana and the coast. As well as absorbing more CO2, street trees cool the summer heat and provide shelter from the wind.

We would like the Five Towns Trail funded and consideration given to connecting to other walking trails. We also agree with the proposal to create housing by Woodside STation as long as there is also a plan for some basic amenities such as school and shop too, so people aren't dependent for car journeys for everything other than commuting by train. The WoodsideTrail is a real community asset.

#3 Footpaths needs to be extended in Wood Street, Greytown to the town boundaries. This is a dangerous stretch of road, with 2 bus stops, and is used by a lot of people - walking, running, cycling, taking young children in prams and push-chairs etc.

I have submitted a hard copy at the Greytown library. This is an another issue that I want to address. Greytown town centre lacks green space and this is most noticeable during the summer months when the pavements get very hot. Council owns some land between Main Street and West street where the Menz Shed currently sits. The council has the opportunity to make this into a green walkway between the 2 streets with tubs or permanent plants along the way. Park benches could be spaced at regular intervals along the walkway which would meander between the 2 streets. A small coffee outlet could be located along the walkway either on land leased from the council or on private land or the council could run the business themselves. This plan would add much needed ambience to the town, provide places to sit and rest and to meet with friends. The walkway could also be used as a cycle track.
