
The temporary licence is granted to the applicant in respect of the premises situated at **57 Princess Street, Martinborough** and known as **Martinborough Vineyard**.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this temporary licence shall become effective on **26 November 2021** and expire on the **26 November 2022**.
