DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application by Parehua (2021) Limited for a Temporary On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 52 New York Street West, Martinborough known as "Parehua Resort".

Police and the Inspector have no opposition to this application. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard, as set out in s.3, s.4 and s.136 of the Act. We grant the Temporary On-Licence for three months period from the date of issue.

REASON FOR DECISION
