DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application by **Parehua (2021) Limited** for a Temporary Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 52 New York Street West, Martinborough and known as "**Parehua Resort**".

Police and the Inspector have no opposition to this application. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard, as set out in s.3, s.4 and s.136 of the Act. We grant the Temporary Authority for a three-month period from the date of issue.

REASON FOR DECISION

This application has been considered on the basis of the reports received from the Alcohol Licensing Inspector and the Police. No matters have been raised with the Committee by the reporting agencies that would suggest that this Temporary Off-Licence should not be granted.

The applicant has established that they hold a right, title or estate in the premises, being a requirement under the Act to obtain a Temporary Authority.

The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s136 of the Act, is satisfied all criteria has been met. I therefore grant **Parehua Resort** the Temporary Off-Licence, subject to the conditions of licence 44/OFF/008/2021 which apply to this Temporary Off-Licence, as outlined in (a) to (f) below.

- (a) Alcohol may be sold on or delivered from the premises for consumption off the premises or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: **Monday to Sunday 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.**
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1:00 pm on ANZAC Day.
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, from the location at which the sampling occurs.
- (d) A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- (e) The designation of the premises is to be –
- Entire licensed area **undesignated at all times, except**
 - 1m in front of the bar area in the Pavilion bar is to be **supervised at all times.**
- (f) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display:
- At each principal entrance to the premises, the ordinary operating hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.
 - A copy of the licence and all conditions subject to which it is issued, to the inside of the premises so to be easily read by all people entering at each principal entrance.
 - At every point of sale for alcohol, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
