DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application by **Martinborough Grocery Ltd** for a Temporary Authority in respect of an Off-Licence requesting the applicant be able to sell and supply alcohol from the premises situated at **16 Jellicoe Street Martinborough** known as "**Pain and Kershaw Martinborough Grocery**", while the premises at **14 Memorial Square Martinborough** undergoes major refurbishment and is closed to the public for a period of up to 18 months.

Police and the Inspector have no opposition to this application. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

REASON FOR DECISION

This application has been considered on the basis of the reports received from the Alcohol Licensing Inspector and the Police. No matters have been raised with the Committee by the reporting agencies that would suggest that this Temporary Authority for an Off-Licence should not be granted.

The applicant has established that they hold a right, title, or estate in the premises, being a requirement under the Act to obtain a Temporary Authority.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard, as set out in s.3, s.4, s.74, and s.136 of the Act. The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to s136 of the Act, is satisfied all criteria have been met.

I therefore grant **Pain and Kershaw Martinborough Grocery at 16 Jellicoe Street Martinborough** the Temporary Authority in respect of an Off-Licence, subject to the
